

TECHNICAL NOTES: AGING:

18 months in (30%) new French oak; (60%) older, neutral French oak; and (10%) in older, neutral Hungarian oak barrels

TASTING NOTES:

This Super Tuscan-style blend is composed of Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petite Sirah, and Merlot. With aromas of Maraschino cherries, black pepper, gooseberry, and a beautiful palate with a hint of cherry and cedar, this wine is a nicely balanced blend with assertive yet approachable tannins. This is a big, rich wine that really shines with robust beef dishes such as lamb chops or a homemade lasagna.
