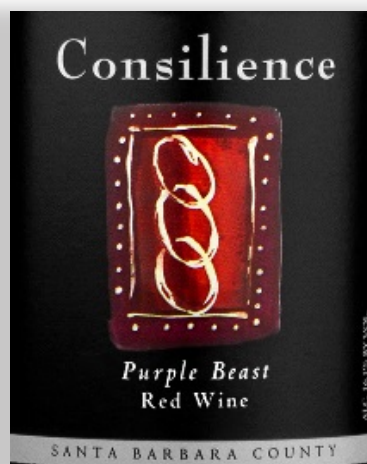

Don't be fooled by its quirky name, Purple Beast packs serious flavor. You're treated to a seductive nose of plum, sage, anise and hints of dried orange peel. The blend of mostly Petite Sirah, Tempranillo, and Syrah has a fruit forward palate of cherry and red plum with earth, truffle and licorice. Try some paired with duck breasts with apricot-Szechuan peppercorn sauce or rosemary & balsamic marinated lamb shanks.
